It's been about 3 years since we last raised our rates, but our expenses go up each year (mostly rent and electricity). We've been using the interest from Arleigh's bequest to help offset our expenses but projections for the coming year show that that may not be enough. We would like to get to the point were we at least break even each month.

So the new membership rates will be \$150 for full membership and \$40 for partial.

With the increase in what we charge for workshops and special events we now usually break even whereas before we almost always lost money
