The Folk Dance Center (FDC) is a non-profit organization of amateur dancers with a common interest in folk dances from around the world. The FDC seeks to increase understanding of world folk dance and to preserve this rich resource for future generations. Membership is open to all. Membership includes discounts on folk dance events and regular evening folk dancing at the FDC, notices of folk dance activities, and a monthly newsletter. Let me start off by saying that 2012 was the year of big changes that didn't happen. With our lease running out we saw an opportunity to move the FDC to a new location that would have better parking and other growth potentials. But that didn't happen. We now have a new 5 year lease at our present location.

We are also looking to make major improvements to our kitchen that will allow for more catered food at parties and such.

Out rent has gone up and it's been 3 years or more since our membership fees have increased. We also lose money every month due to the higher cost of bands and teachers. So starting next month, not only will we raise our membership fees to \$175 and \$50, but we've also added two extra levels. There will be a \$250 level that allows you to attend ALL FDC events at no extra charge, and a \$30 level that takes just \$1 off admission prices. Prices for most classes and events will also be going up. We don't want to see anybody left out of folk dancing due to hardships and we will take care of those folks on a case by case basis.
