While living in Thessaloniki for 2 years of intense study of Greek culture, Kristalli developed a holistic teaching program for dance. With this method she is able to help students understand a deeper understanding of Greek folk music, movement & rhythms. Currently Kristalli lives in Northern California, with her husband, and has begun her practice in bodywork & healing. Along with her work as a physical therapist, she teaches Greek dance to the folkdance community.
